Here are a few examples of the types of combinations I'll be planting this season:

Sun-Loving Combinations

Bright geraniums paired with petunias and calibrachoa for long-lasting color

Salvia mixed with white blooms and trailing blue flowers for a classic look

Warm summer tones like lantana, zinnias, and nasturtiums for a bold pop

Shade & Part-Shade Combinations

Coleus and begonias with trailing greenery for colorful foliage

Ferns paired with impatiens for a lush, full look

Soft mixes of astilbe, begonias, and light trailing plants for a calm feel

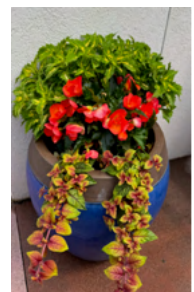
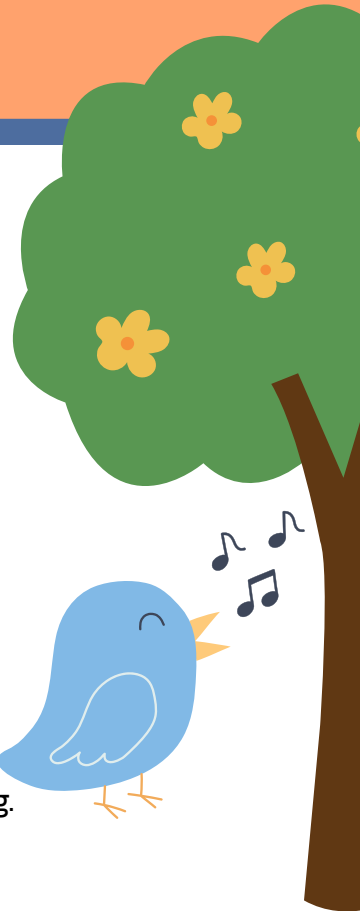
I enjoy mixing colors, leaf shapes, and bloom styles while keeping watering needs and exposure in mind.

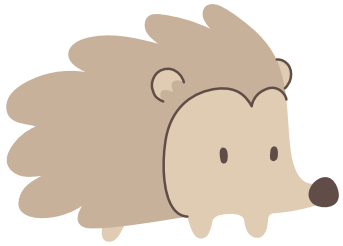
